## Opening Hook (2 minutes)

*"Industry research predicts 40% of agentic AI projects will be canceled by 2027. Let me tell you what that actually means. It doesn't mean the technology failed. Agentic AI works. It means organizations couldn't figure out where AI creates value, couldn't govern it safely, couldn't scale it without chaos, and couldn't preserve the human expertise needed to keep improving it."*

**Visual:** Single slide with '40%' large, then reveal 'Not technology failure. Adoption failure.'

## The Counterintuitive Truth (3 minutes)

*"Most people think AI governance is about restriction. More autonomy means less oversight. This is exactly backwards. The organizations building real AI capability have discovered that more autonomy requires MORE sophisticated oversight, not less."*

## The Four Failure Modes (5 minutes)

**Discovery Failure:** They're waiting for top-down strategy to identify use cases. But no one in a boardroom knows which AI applications will work on the ground.

**Governance Failure:** They have binary 'allowed/forbidden' policies when the answer is 'it depends on the workflow.'

**Capability Failure:** 73% of their people use AI the same way they did in 2023. No structure, no progression.

**Expertise Failure:** Their people are hollowing out - keeping titles while losing craft.

# THE COMPLETE SYSTEM

Four Components for AI Success

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## Component 1: Discovery (AWIC)

Monthly cycle: Discover > Prototype > Validate > Standardize. Output: Growing AI Workflow Library. 'Policy grows from practice, not theory.'

## Component 2: Governance (Guardrail Matrix)

Task risk x data sensitivity x automation depth x audit intensity. The counterintuitive key: More autonomy = more auditing.

## Component 3: Capability (Evolution Ladder)

5 stages from Single LLM to Automated. Human role evolves: Worker > Supervisor > Manager > Executive > Governor. '73% are stuck at Stage 1.'

## Component 4: Expertise (Anti-Hollowing)

First Draft, Not First Thought. Your expertise goes INTO specialist definitions. 'AI elevates human expertise rather than replacing it.'

## What To Do Monday (5 minutes)

### For CIOs:

Implement the monthly discovery cycle. Deploy the Guardrail Matrix with audit intensity that scales UP. Measure Evolution Ladder distribution.

### For Business Leaders:

Advance your team beyond Stage 1. Build your first specialists. Participate in validation.

### For Executives:

Require the complete system, not point solutions. Ask to see the workflow library, audit ladder, and capability progression.

# CLOSE

Execution Separates the 60% from the 40%

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*"The 40% who will fail are making a common mistake. They think AI adoption is a technology problem. It's not. It's an organizational capability problem. The technology works. The question is whether your organization can discover where it creates value, govern it safely, build capability that compounds, and preserve the human expertise you need. That's an execution question."*
